### **What is Osteopathic Medicine**

MD's practice allopathic medicine, the classical form of medicine, focused on the diagnosis and treatment of human diseases. DO's practice osteopathic medicine which is centered around a more holistic view of medicine in which the focus is on seeing the patient as a "whole person" to reach a diagnosis, rather than treating the symptoms alone.

Osteopathic medicine is a branch of the medical profession in the United States. Osteopathic doctors (D.O.s) can become fully licensed physicians able to practice medicine and surgery in all 50 states and are recognized to varying degrees in 65 other countries.

Osteopathic physicians represent 6% of the physician workforce in the U.S., but graduate 10% of the total physicians. Three new osteopathic schools will receive provisional accreditation in 2006

and several more are planned for 2007 and 2008. Allopathic physicians represent 94% of the physician pool.
